Nashville's Mayor, Chamber of Commerce and Nashville Technology Council join 365 to launch data center and Tech Hub in support of hi-tech businesses and entrepreneurs in downtown Nashville

Nashville, Nov. 13, 2014 – 365 Data Centers, one of the top U.S. colocation providers by market presence, today announced the launch of its 17,000 square foot data center in downtown Nashville and the [365 Nashville Tech Hub](#), an initiative that provides incentives and free services to local hi-tech startups and businesses. Announced today at a ribbon cutting ceremony featuring Nashville's Mayor Karl Dean and leaders from the Chamber of Commerce and the Nashville Technology Council, 365 Data Centers' Tech Hub will provide free colocation services including space, power and Internet connectivity for local businesses and entrepreneurs.

During the ribbon cutting ceremony today, 365 will showcase the facility's new Tech Hub, upgraded N+1 parallel redundancy power and cooling systems and uninterruptible power supply (UPS) capabilities at what is the only HIPAA and SSAE 16 compliant colocation facility located in downtown Nashville. The event will be held from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. CST at 365 Data Centers' Nashville facility located at 147 4th Avenue North, 8th Floor, Nashville, with an open-house and data center tours to follow.
